

## Quick Guide to Online Journals via Full Text Finder

## Full Text Finder is a state-of-the-art service for you to easily locate journals held in the library and link out to full-text articles.

**Step 1.** Login onto the website <u>https://www.irishcollegeofgps.ie/</u> with your **email** and **password**. You must be logged in to access the journals as they are for **members only**.

Step 2. You will find the Online Journals in the Clinical Hub under Publications and Journals.

Step 3. Under Access Journals via Full Text Finder, click on the link Online Journals for GPs.

**Step 4.** You will be brought to the **Full Text Finder.** This is where you can do a search for a journal simply by entering the title in the search box e.g. BMJ. As well as searching by journal title you can search for a particular subject to bring up any relevant journals e.g. medical education. Here you can also browse by discipline and use 'Ask a Librarian' to contact the library.
